Pet Memory Candle

List of supplies:

Candle in glass jar
Roll of twine, yarn, or hemp
Super Glue
Craft foam
Rubber stamps
Craft paints and brushes
Jewels, beads, or other embellishments
Scissors

SAFETY NOTE: Children should always be supervised. Be sure to protect your surface.

- 1 Print the directions. Be sure that the surface you will be working on is covered. Super glue is sticky, so please use care!

You will want to do a little pre-planning and decide just what types of things to embellish your project. We decided on craft foam and rubber stamps but you may want to use other things.

- 2 To start, you'll need to begin wrapping your twine or yarn from the bottom. It's easiest to place the candle upside down at first as you wrap.

Carefully apply the super glue around the bottom edge. We applied one thin line of glue and then started to wrap with the twine. Once you've gone around a few times, you'll get the hang of it.

As you continue to wrap the candle, make sure you continue to apply the glue so that the twine stays put. You can go as far up the side as you like, just be sure it doesn't get too close to the flame.



- 3 Be sure the twine is in place and the glue is dry before proceeding to the next step.



- 4 Finally, use whatever you like to embellish and decorate the candle. You can even use photographs of your pet or poems and verses. The only limit is your imagination.

***Please be careful with your candle. Keep children and pets away from the flame when lit.**

NEVER LEAVE THE CANDLE UNATTENDED WHEN LIT.
