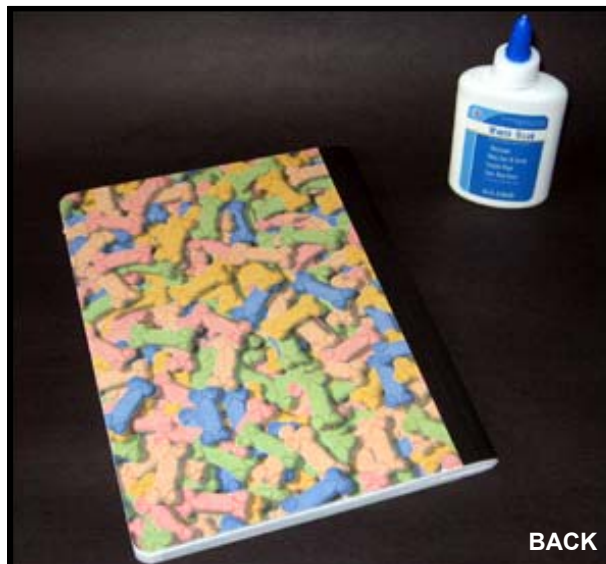
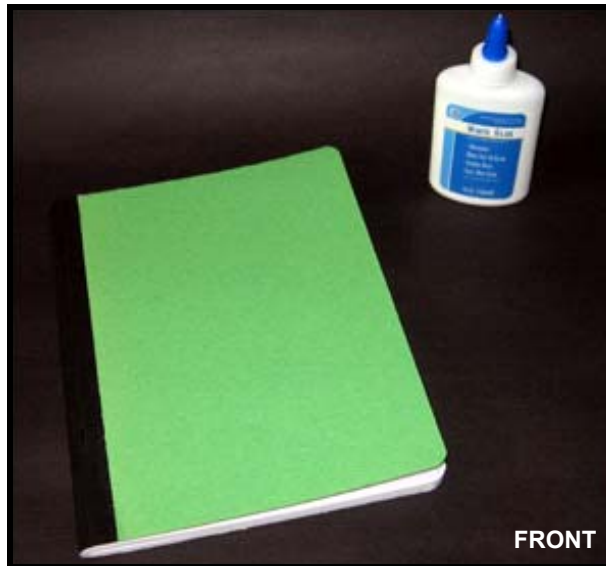
Composition Notebook
Various craft papers
Construction paper
Rubber stamps
Paints or markers
Cut-outs or paper embellishments
Stencils
Craft glue
Scissors

SAFETY NOTE: Children should always be supervised. Be sure to protect your surface.

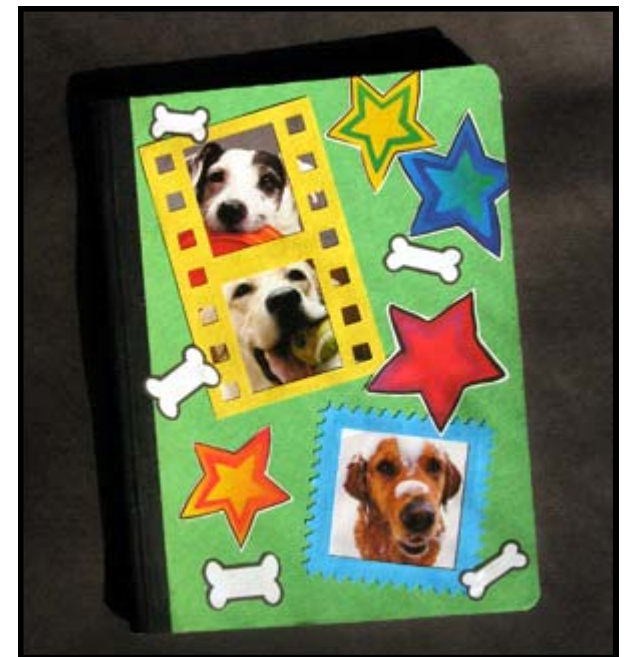
- 1 Print the directions. You may want to start by laying out your materials and photos, etc., and experimenting with the different colors and papers. This way, you'll have an idea of how your completed journal will look before hand and you can work towards that goal.



- 2 Use craft glue to fasten the paper to the composition book cover. Rather than try to cut the paper to fit, it's best to use a whole sheet and trim with scissors when the glue has dried.



- 3 Use rubber stamps, paints, markers, paper cut-outs, photos and whatever other kinds of embellishments you like to decorate the cover(s).



***Note:** If making this project as a gift, you could use photos of the person's pet. If possible, take the photos to an office supply store and have color copies made.

This is also a good idea when using your own priceless images.
