

Name That Animal - Second Grade

OBJECTIVE

To learn to identify the sounds that different animals make.

ACTIVITY OVERVIEW

Students start by discussing the sounds that different animals make. They will play a listening game and try to identify the sounds made by other students. This part of the lesson can be also played in teams.

MATERIALS

- Animal cards (included in this lesson plan)

DISCUSSION

- Using the cards as a guide, ask the students what kinds of sound each animal makes. What are some of the reason why the animal might make the sound? Does the animal have more than one sound it makes?

ACTIVITY

- Print and cut out the animal cards. Fold them in half and place them in a container where they can be drawn by students. Allow students (either individually or in teams) to draw a card and then make the sound of the animal listed on the card. If playing in teams, keep track of correct answers and tally scores.

POST DISCUSSION

- Ask the students if they know of other animals and what kinds of sounds they make.
